Suspension of Face-to-face Classes

8th September, 2022

Dear Parents,

In view of the recent escalation of the COVID-19 epidemic, our school was notified again in the afternoon of 8th September, 2022 that one boarding staff tested positive for a polymerase chain reaction test on the same day. The last working day of the staff was 6th September, 2022 and he/she was on leave since 7th September, 2022.

Because of the positive results of the rapid antigen test or polymerase chain reaction test, or the close contacts of the confirmed cases of COVID-19 defined by the Centre for Health Protection. In order to protect the health and safety of students, with the consent of the Incorporated Management Committee, the school will suspend face-to-face classes from 9th September, 2022 and conduct online classes as scheduled until 14th September, 2022. Face-to-face classes will resume on 15th September, 2022. Please refer to the student handbook for login details of online classes.

During the suspension of face-to-face classes, the school will be opened. We will arrange staff to be on duty to look after students who have to go back to school because of the lack of carers at home, and to handle teaching affairs, school affairs and parents' enquiries. The school will continue to strengthen the cleaning and disinfection work on the campus, and will strictly comply with various hygiene protection measures to ensure the cleanliness of the school buses and the campus environment.

Furthermore, parent should take precautionary measures for COVID-19 and pay close attention to the health condition of child. Please avoid bringing your child to crowded places with poor ventilation and maintain him/her a balanced diet, exercise regularly as well as take adequate rest in order to strengthen the immunity. If he/she is feeling unwell (even if the symptoms are very mild), please seek medical advice promptly to receive appropriate diagnoses and treatments.

The school will keep close contact with the Center for Health Protection and closely monitor the health conditions of our staff and students.
