2022 – 2023 Parents Notice
Arrangements for face-to-face classes starting from December

10th November, 2022

Dear Parents,

[This is the summary of the Chinese Version as attached]

The Education Bureau (EDB) issued a letter to all schools in Hong Kong on 25th October, 2022, announcing the latest arrangements of face-to-face classes.

For secondary schools, the existing whole-day face-to-face class arrangements (i.e. 90 % or more of the total number of students of the whole school or an individual class level eligible to receive vaccination have received two doses of vaccine for more than 14 days may apply to the EDB for whole-day face-to-face classes) will continue until 31st January, 2023.

For primary schools, in order to allow primary students to gradually resume normal school life, starting from 1st December, 2022, if the number of students of individual primary schools reach 70 % or more of the total number of students of the whole school or an individual class level eligible to receive vaccination have received two doses of vaccine for more than 14 days, those schools may apply to the EDB. The EDB will take into account the actual circumstances of schools to allow them to resume whole-day face-to-face classes for the whole school or individual class levels.

As all teachers and staff directly employed by schools (including teaching and non-teaching staff) have met the requirements of “Vaccine Pass”. Students in the Secondary section who have completed two doses of the vaccine and more than 14 days have reached more than 90% of the school-wide vaccinated students. Students in the Primary section who have completed two doses of the vaccine and more than 14 days have reached the school-wide vaccinated population more than 80% of the population. Our school has obtained the consent of the Incorporated Management Committee and has been approved by the EDB to arrange whole-day face-to-face classes for all students from 1st December, 2022. Please see the attachment for the schedule of each class.

In addition, the arrangement of daily rapid antigen testing must continue until further notice.

Parents are encouraged to urge your child to adjust the daily routine, go to bed early and get up early every day to prepare for classes. The school will do the best to maintain campus hygiene and protect the health of students. We hope that students enjoy school life in a safe environment. Parents also need to pay attention to the latest announcements of the Education Bureau (EDB) and school.
