2022 – 2023 Parents Notice

Classes arrangement starting from 1st March

18th January, 2023

Dear Parents,

[This is the summary of the Chinese Version as attached]

The Education Bureau (EDB) announced on 30th December, 2022 that Starting from 1st February, 2023, all secondary schools (including secondary sections of special schools) will fully resume whole-day face-to-face classes. Starting from 15th February, 2023, all primary schools (including primary sections of special schools) and kindergartens will fully resume whole-day face-to-face classes, in order to resume normal school life in a gradual and orderly manner. Therefore, our school will stop providing online classes from 1st March, 2023.

If students have not returned to Hong Kong, parents are kindly requested to make plans and arrangements so that students can return to school for face-to-face classes on 1st March, 2023. If boarders need to go back to the dormitory, parents are kindly requested to contact the warden or assistant warden for follow-up and arrangement.

As the Chinese New Year Holiday is approaching, teachers and students are kindly requested to continue to stay vigilant and pay attention to personal hygiene to reduce the risk of infection. Our school will continue to strictly put in place the various anti-epidemic measures stipulated in the “Health Advice to Schools for the Prevention of COVID-19” issued by the CHP. The measures include having school personnel wearing masks at all times within school campuses, maintaining appropriate social distances, and measuring temperatures of teachers and students at school entrances. Our school will keep school environment clean and hygienic, in order to safeguard the health of teachers and students.

Besides, in order to reduce the risk of transmission, the school will follow the requirements of the EDB and continue to maintain the daily body temperature measurement and rapid antigen test for staff and students before returning to school until 28th February, 2023. If the family member or carer who lives with the student tested positive in the rapid antigen test or polymerase chain reaction test, parents are requested to notify the school nurse as soon as possible for follow-up.
